

Pre-Installation

Checklist

- Confirm the model number on the packaging matches the ordered sink.
- Do not install if incorrect.
- Inspect the sink for any visible defects.
- Do not install if damaged. Contact place of purchase.
- Ensure the sink is on-site before cutting the benchtop for accurate fit.

Installation Compliance

- All installations must be completed by a licensed plumber.
- Installations must comply with AS/NZS 3500 and local plumbing codes.

Important

- Ensure the cabinet is installed on a level surface and adjustable feet are correctly set.
- Confirm all plumbing connections are secure and leak-free before use.
- If a washing machine bypass kit is installed, ensure correct configuration for the appliance type (top or front loader).
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the cabinet to minimise moisture build-up.

Care & Maintenance

General

- Clean sink and cabinet regularly with warm water, mild detergent, and a soft cloth.
- Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry to prevent water spots and residue build-up.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, powders, or scouring pads.
- Avoid harsh chemicals such as acids, bleach, or solvents.
- Keep cabinet surfaces dry and well ventilated to prevent moisture build-up.
- Clean door hinges and internal areas periodically to maintain operation.

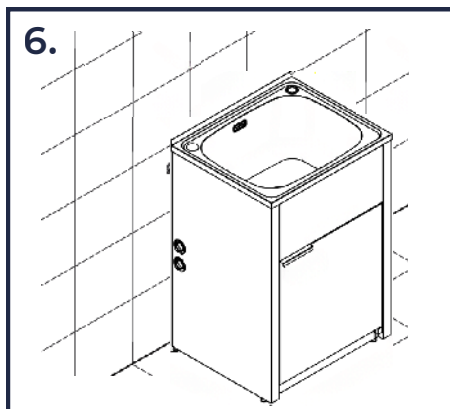
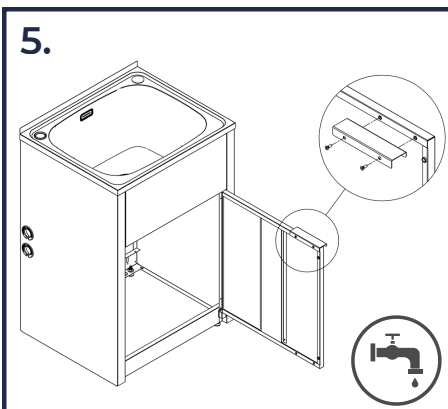
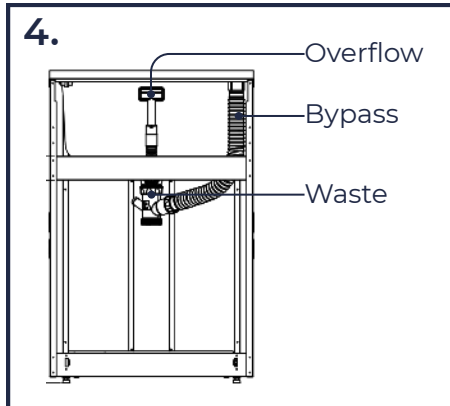
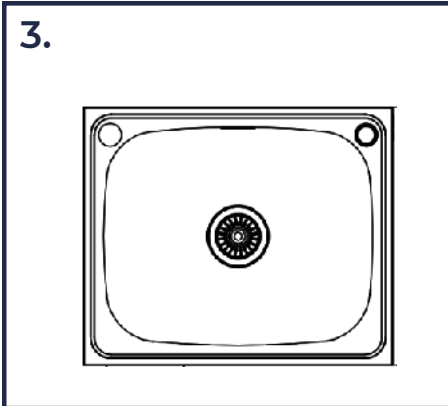
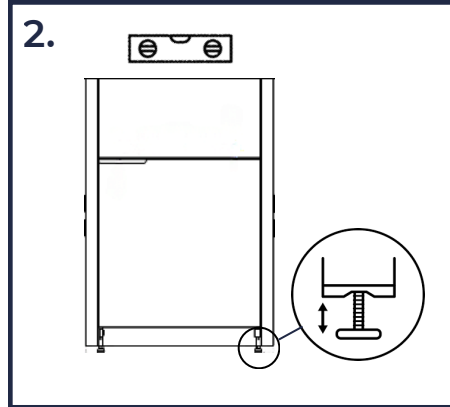
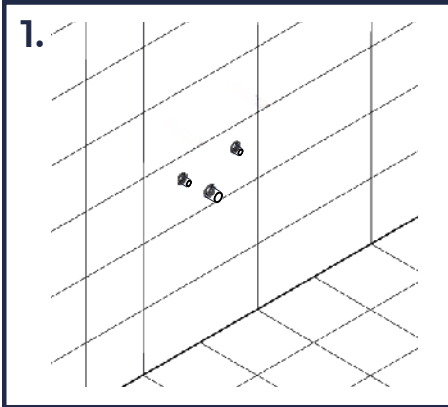
Stain Removal

- Remove spills and stains promptly to prevent marking.
- For general stains, use warm water and a mild cleaner.
- For stainless steel sinks, wipe in the direction of the grain where applicable.
- For mineral deposits, use a mild solution of vinegar and water, then rinse thoroughly.
- For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner with a soft cloth or sponge.
- Always rinse and dry after cleaning.

Important Usage Notes

- Do not place extremely hot items directly into the sink without protection.
- Avoid dropping heavy or sharp objects into the sink, as this may cause damage.
- Do not use the sink as a cutting surface.
- Do not store harsh chemicals inside the cabinet, as fumes may affect the finish.
- Ensure washing machine hoses and connections are secure to prevent leaks.

LAUNDRY SINK & CABINET



1. Prepare Area

- Ensure floor is level and services (water and waste) are correctly positioned.
- Confirm door opening direction (left or right hinge).
- Confirm location of washing machine connections (left or right).

2. Assemble Cabinet

- Fit adjustable feet to the cabinet base.
- Install and align the door to the desired opening direction (reversible).
- Position cabinet and adjust feet until level.

3. Install Sink

- Place the stainless steel sink into the cabinet.
- Secure in position as required.
- If not using a tap or bypass, install the tap hole cover.

4. Install Plumbing Components

- Fit waste to the sink and connect overflow (if applicable).
- Install tapware if required.
- If using a washing machine bypass kit, install to suit the correct configuration.

5. Install Handle & Connect Services

- Fix handle to top position using supplied screws.
- Connect water supply to tap and washing machine connections.
- Connect waste outlet to bypass kit.
- Connect washing machine waste to bypass kit or directly to waste spigot.
- Check all connections are secure.

Test & Finish

- Turn on water and check for leaks.
- Test sink, tapware, and bypass functionality.
- Ensure cabinet is level, door is aligned, and all components operate correctly.
